Elder: What does God teach us about...?

People: God's people respond and say what they believe.



Call to renewal:

Pastor Matt picks Scripture to go here. When we hear or read Scripture we know that we can not live perfectly so we ask God to forgive us and help make our hearts new and loving through Jesus who died for us and can do all things perfectly.

Confession of sin:

As a family we join together to tell God we are sorry for our sins because none of us are good. We all need forgiveness. Did the prayer ask God for forgiveness? Yes or No? Underline the things the prayer says we are sorry for.

"Our heavenly Father, ...amen."

Words of assurance:

This is Scripture, God's very words which are truth. Assurance means to speak something with confidence or certainty.

Return to me, and I will return to you, says the LORD of hosts. But you say, 'How shall we return?' Will man rob God? Yet you are robbing me. But you say, 'How have we robbed you?' In your tithes and contributions. ⁹ You are cursed with a curse, for you are robbing me, the whole nation of you. ¹⁰ Bring the full tithe into the storehouse, that there may be food in my house. And thereby put me to the test, says the LORD of hosts, if I will not open the window of heaven for you and pour down for you a blessing until there is no more need. ¹¹ I will rebuke the devourer for you, so that it will not destroy the fruits of your soil, and your vine in the field shall not fail to bear, says the LORD of hosts. ¹² Then all nations will call you blessed, for you will be a land of delight, says the LORD of hosts.

The congregation will respond to God after his blessing with thankful hearts in song.






